Scholarship applications deadline April 13th

Paulding, OH: The JP Crain Scholarship Fund was established by the Crain Family to provide scholarship grants to graduates of Paulding County Schools. The fund is administered by the Paulding County Area Foundation. The Foundation also awards their own scholarship as well.

Foundation has awarded 65 scholarships for a total of \$44,250 to students in Paulding County. The number of scholarships granted each year as well as their amounts will vary based on funds available and the number of qualified applicants.

“Many people don’t realize that even current college students can apply for the scholarship,” says recent college graduate Mikayla Pieper. Applying for scholarships even after senior year of high school is vital due to the cost of a college education. “I’m thankful that the Foundation continues to award current college students as well as high school students seeking a college education,” says Pieper.
